### SENIOR INTERCLUB REPLY FORM 2016/2017

Kohimarama Tennis Club asks all players who wish to play interclub to complete this form.

Once completed, please return to Gill Blower via return email, post, or through the mail slot at the office, by Sunday 24th July. Copies are also available on the club website, Interclub page.

**All interclub players must be financial members.**

The Interclub season runs from September to March, with each team playing every second week.

**The starting date for Saturday play this season will be Saturday 3rd September.** Please expect to start on this date or the week following. The draws will be placed on the Tennis Auckland's website late - August, members will be advised by email of their team and captains will be given a copy of the draw, balls and other relevant information as soon as possible after the closing date with Tennis Auckland.

Most interclub teams play 10 or 11 matches. To be a member of a team, **you must commit to play for the season, barring injuries and unforeseen events.** If you are able to make this commitment, complete the following form. If you are unable to make this commitment but would like to be a reserve, please fill in the appropriate section(s). The expectation of team members is that there will be at least one practice every two weeks.

**Selection of team members is chosen with the best interests of Kahi Tennis Club at heart. Individual requests will be taken into consideration, especially in the Open grades, but not promised. For doubles play, please note any preferred playing partner to be considered – but we can't promise!**

**Play-offs may be held for places in promotion/relegation teams, depending on numbers of entries.**

We appreciate you giving us as much info as possible now, so that team captains have all reserves and contact info at the start of the season. Please keep Gill updated if your details change.

#### Interclub fees

Interclub fees are paid by the Club. However, to cover ball costs you will be invoiced separately for balls based on the discounted price the Club can get for balls. Only regular players (minimum of 5 per team) are charged ball fees to cover the cost of balls per team for the season. If you only want to reserve then no fee is charged, but if you reserve regularly you are expected to pay some ball costs to the team. The anticipated cost per person will be the following:

**Selection meetings may be held during the first week of August. These dates will be advertised to all club members if it is deemed to be of interest to members to hold them.**

#### Competitions available on Saturday

- 1. Singles** – Open to all members. Teams of 4 men or women who all play singles (best of three sets) and a doubles (super tiebreaker at 1 set all). We would look at having 5 or 6 members per team to allow for injuries and times when a team member is not available to play.
- 2. Presidents Doubles** – team of 8 (4 men, 4 women,) over 30 years of age. All play a doubles and a mixed doubles match (super tiebreaker at 1 set all). We would anticipate having extras named in these teams to allow for injuries and times when a member is not available to play.
- 3. Super Tennis** – team of 4 men or 4 women. Each person plays 3 doubles matches, first to 9 games, match takes approx 3 hours and starts at 12 noon or 3pm. We would look at having 5 or 6 members per team to allow for injuries and times when a team member is not available to play.

## Twilight Competitions on Monday or Tuesday night.

This competition runs separately to the Saturday competition. First round will start 31<sup>st</sup> October  
Twilight is played during daylight saving months November to March. **Matches start at 6.30pm.** We are asked to try to start on time so that lights should not be needed.

1. **Singles** - Teams of 2, 3 or 4 men or women. Two singles and a doubles. Two sets, super tiebreaker at 1 set all, sudden death deuces.
2. **Doubles** – Teams of 4 men or 4 women. Each person plays 2 doubles. Two sets, super tiebreaker at 1 set all, sudden death deuces. We would look at having 5 or 6 players per team to allow for injuries and times when a team member is not available to play.
